**Sub: Initiating Road Safety Patrol unit (RSP) in your school reg.**

Let us introduce ourselves as a voluntary Organisation involved in Road Safety Education. Considering the enormity of the traffic problems faced by the public in city, we are striving hard to inculcate Traffic Sense to all and in particular School and College students; who will develop important qualities and personal skills, including leadership and a sense of social responsibility. We already have more than 7000 Road Safety Patrol cadets enrolled from 59 city schools and 19 colleges of which most are now functional.

We now propose to initiate a **Road Safety Patrol (RSP)** unit in your school and hence this request. In order to have a uniform pattern of Road Safety Patrol program in Coimbatore city we wish to provide you some basic information on its activities.

The **RSP** will function in such a way that they will keep the school gates free of congestion without coming on to the road. 10 minutes prior to the school timing in the morning and in the evening, they will make the walking space (footpath) near the school clear of parking of vehicles to allow smooth flow of school students, so they will not go directly to the road. Secondly they will not allow any vehicle to Stand, Park, Stop, Pickup/Drop students in front of the school gate.

To commence this in your college we would request you to

- Appoint one RSP coordinator.
- Enroll a minimum of 100 students to whom we will impart training and enroll them for RSP.

We would appreciate if the list of students willing to enroll as RSP cadet along with details on RSP teacher, be forwarded to us at the earliest, so that training and other programs may be commenced. All Students enrolled in the RSP unit will receive certificates of participation. Should you require any further assistance / clarifications do not hesitate to call Mr. Leonard Bernardin, RSP Coordinator at 99944 25100.

I thank you for your attention and it is our sincere hope that this would make our city college students more aware of road safety.
