<i>Brief</i>	<p>Wait for green signal.</p> <p>Not to alight buses at signal.</p> <p>Stop at stop line.</p> <p>Understand red, amber and green lights.</p>	<p>Drive only in one lane.</p> <p>Cross lane only with signal and when road is clear.</p> <p>At signal wait at the correct lane and well before stop line.</p> <p>Understand broken and unbroken white / yellow lines.</p> <p>Understand white shoulder line on edge of road.</p>	<p>On public roads - Do not drive in triplets.</p> <p>- Avoid over speeding / rash driving.</p> <p>- Avoid zig zag driving.</p> <p>- Avoid drink and driving.</p> <p>- Avoid parallel driving.</p> <p>- Avoid wheeling (front and back).</p>	<p>Avoid using cell phone while driving.</p> <p>Using hands free sets or blue tooth devises of cell phone while driving is an offense.</p> <p>Talking on cell phone while driving is more dangerous than drunk driving.</p> <p>Attending call on cell phones while a Pillion rider holds it is also an offense.</p>	<p>Always use helmets while driving two wheelers.</p> <p>Data on your brain are very precious. Don't lose it.</p> <p>Always wear a well fit helmet.</p> <p>Chin strap the helmet fully fit. It is an offense not strapping the helmet.</p> <p>Pillion driver should also wear helmet.</p>
